



Public Performance Tariff C: Cinemas (film exhibitors) and theatres	
Effective Date	This Tariff applies from 1 July 2017
What is licensed under this Tariff?	Protected sound recordings
What uses are covered by this Tariff?	<p>This Tariff covers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) the public exhibition of films which include protected sound recordings as part of their soundtrack (regardless of premises or format); and (b) the playing of sound recordings as background music at theatres (i.e. buildings/rooms designed specifically for dramatic presentations, stage performances and the like). <p>This Tariff <u>does not</u> cover the playing of sound recordings in foyers, corridors, bars, candy shops and other common areas of cinemas and theatres. Please refer to the relevant Tariff(s) for the applicable Licence Fees and other details.</p>
What are the Licence Fees?	<p>For cinemas and other film exhibitors:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) \$327.81 per screen, per annum; or (b) \$163.86 per annum for those cinemas with a single screen <u>and</u> seven (7) or less screenings per week. <p>For theatres:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (c) \$62.84 per theatre, per annum for theatres with two (2) or less performances per week; or (d) \$81.98 per theatre, per annum for theatres with three (3) or more performances per week. <p>Note that a separate Licence Fee is payable (calculated at the rates specified above) for each cinema screen or theatre in a multi-cinema/theatre complex.</p>

Special conditions applicable to this Tariff	None

ALL LICENCE FEES UNDER THIS TARIFF ARE PAYABLE IN FULL, ANNUALLY IN ADVANCE. ALL AMOUNTS ARE INCLUSIVE OF GST.

PPCA will generally increase Licence Fees with effect from 1 July of each year, in line with the movement in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) since the date of the last increase or review. CPI increases will not be notified to Licensees separately, but will be applied to all invoices issued on or after 1 July in each year. Any increase in Licence Fees as a result of a broad or structural review of a Tariff will only be implemented following a period of consultation with the affected industry sector.
