



Public Performance Tariff E3: Bars – Foreground Music	
Effective Date	This Tariff applies from 1 July 2010
What is licensed under this Tariff?	Protected sound recordings
What uses are covered by this Tariff?	<p>This Tariff covers the playing of protected sound recordings at a bar or similar venue as a predominant means of entertaining patrons.</p> <p>This Tariff <u>does not</u> cover:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ the playing of protected sound recordings at Nightclubs (as defined in Tariff E1), Dances or Dance Parties (as defined in Tariff E2); ▪ the playing of protected sound recordings as background music in bar areas (covered by Tariff M) or restaurants (covered by Tariff R1); ▪ the playing of protected sound recordings through jukeboxes (covered by Tariff J); or ▪ the public exhibition of music videos (covered by Tariff W).
What are the Licence Fees?	<p>The Licence Fee is the greater of:</p> <p>(a) \$0.044 per person per night of operation, for each person of the venue's Capacity; or</p> <p>(b) \$146.08 (minimum annual fee).</p> <p>In this Tariff, the “Capacity” of a venue is the number of patrons licensed by the Local Government, Liquor Licensing Body or Fire Department (as applicable to that venue).</p> <p>Note that a separate Licence Fee is payable for each room, level or other area where protected sound recordings are played. If a venue has more than one room, level or other area, then each of those areas incurs a separate Licence Fee calculated at the rate specified above.</p> <p><u>Example:</u></p> <p>A bar has a DJ on Friday and Saturday nights, mixing recorded music for the enjoyment of patrons. The bar has a capacity of 250 people and is open every week of the year.</p> <p>The Licence Fee will be calculated as follows: 250 people x \$0.044 per person x 2 nights of operation per week x 52 weeks of the year = \$1,144.00.</p>

ALL LICENCE FEES UNDER THIS TARIFF ARE PAYABLE IN FULL, ANNUALLY IN ADVANCE. ALL AMOUNTS ARE INCLUSIVE OF GST.

PPCA will generally increase Licence Fees with effect from 1 July of each year, in line with the movement in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) since the date of the last increase or review. CPI increases will not be notified to Licensees separately, but will be applied to all invoices issued on or after 1 July in each year. Any increase in Licence Fees as a result of a broad or structural review of a Tariff will only be implemented following a period of consultation with the affected industry sector.
