Effective Date	This Tariff applies from 1 July 2017																
What is licensed under this Tariff?	Protected sound recordings																
What uses are covered by this Tariff?	<p>This Tariff covers the playing of protected sound recordings by:</p> <p>(a) Mobile DJs; and/or</p> <p>(b) any person who is using a Mobile DJ Unit supplied by the PPCA licence holder.</p> <p>In this Tariff:</p> <p><b>“Mobile DJ”</b> refers to a DJ who is performing at a venue that does not otherwise require a PPCA licence (i.e. in circumstances that are not covered by any other Tariff), regardless of whose equipment the DJ is using (his or her own, the venue’s or a Mobile DJ Unit).</p> <p><b>“Mobile DJ Unit”</b> refers to equipment that a DJ may need to perform at a venue that does not supply its own equipment. This may include turntables, CD players, digital music storage devices, mixers, amplifiers and speakers. Some of this equipment is referred to in the industry as a “deck”.</p> <p>This Tariff <u>does not</u> cover:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ the playing of protected sound recordings at Nightclubs (as defined in Tariff E1), Dances or Dance Parties (as defined in Tariff E2);</li> <li>▪ the playing of protected sound recordings as a predominant means of entertaining patrons in a bar or similar venue (covered by Tariff E3);</li> <li>▪ the public exhibition of music videos by Mobile VJs or in connection with the use of a Mobile VJ Unit (covered by Tariff FW); or</li> <li>▪ the playing of protected sound recordings at a ticketed, multi-act music event (covered by Tariff E4).</li> </ul>

PPCA will generally increase Licence Fees with effect from 1 July of each year, in line with the movement in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) since the date of the last increase or review. CPI increases will not be notified to Licensees separately, but will be applied to all invoices issued on or after 1 July in each year. Any increase in Licence Fees as a result of a broad or structural review of a Tariff will only be implemented following a period of consultation with the affected industry sector.
