



Public Performance Tariff JO:	Audio jukebox operators
Effective Date	This Tariff applies from 1 July 2017
What is licensed under this Tariff?	Protected sound recordings
What uses are covered by this Tariff?	<p>This Tariff covers the playing of protected sound recordings by any person who is using an audio jukebox supplied and/or operated by the PPCA licence holder.</p> <p>This Tariff is intended for audio jukebox operators that lease, hire or otherwise supply machines to clubs, amusement centres, hotels and other venues, and/or for general party hire.</p> <p>This Tariff <u>does not</u> cover video jukebox operators (covered by Tariff JW).</p>
What are the Licence Fees?	<p>The fee is:</p> <p>(a) \$131.98 for one machine; and</p> <p>(b) \$98.84 per machine for operators with two or more machines.</p>
Licence Period	Annual
Special conditions applicable to this Tariff	<p>The licence holder must provide PPCA with an annual site declaration containing the following information:</p> <p>(a) in relation to each permanent establishment (i.e. club, amusement centre, hotel or other venue) to which jukeboxes are supplied: the venue name and location address, the number of jukeboxes supplied to the venue, and the licence holder's reference number (where applicable); and</p> <p>(b) in relation to party hire activities: the number of jukeboxes and a general description of those activities, including the location (e.g. Sutherland Shire (Sydney) or Cairns).</p> <p>The site declaration must be provided at the time of licence commencement and then at the time of the annual renewal.</p>

ALL LICENCE FEES UNDER THIS TARIFF ARE PAYABLE IN FULL, ANNUALLY IN ADVANCE. ALL AMOUNTS ARE INCLUSIVE OF GST.

PPCA will generally increase Licence Fees with effect from 1 July of each year, in line with the movement in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) since the date of the last increase or review. CPI increases will not be notified to Licensees separately, but will be applied to all invoices issued on or after 1 July in each year. Any increase in Licence Fees as a result of a broad or structural review of a Tariff will only be implemented following a period of consultation with the affected industry sector.
