



Public Performance Tariff JW:	Video jukebox operators
Effective Date	This Tariff applies from 1 July 2017
What is licensed under this Tariff?	Music videos
What uses are covered by this Tariff?	<p>This Tariff covers the public exhibition of music videos by any person who is using a video jukebox or other music video equipment supplied and/or operated by the PPCA licence holder.</p> <p>This Tariff is intended for video jukebox operators that lease, hire or otherwise supply machines to clubs, amusement centres, hotels and other venues, and/or for general party hire.</p> <p>This Tariff <u>does not</u> cover audio jukebox operators (covered by Tariff JO).</p>
What are the Licence Fees?	<p>The Licence Fees are calculated on the basis of the number of screens/display panels operated by the licence holder, as follows:</p> <p>(a) \$394.90 per base unit with single screen; and</p> <p>(b) \$98.03 for each additional screen.</p>
Licence Period	Annual
Special conditions applicable to this Tariff	<p>The licence holder must provide PPCA with an annual site declaration containing the following information:</p> <p>(a) in relation to each permanent establishment (i.e. club, amusement centre, hotel or other venue) to which video jukeboxes are supplied: the venue name and location address, the number of video jukeboxes supplied to the venue, and the licence holder's reference number (where applicable); and</p> <p>(b) in relation to party hire activities: the number of video jukeboxes and a general description of those activities, including the location (e.g. Sutherland Shire (Sydney) or Cairns).</p> <p>The site declaration must be provided at the time of licence commencement and then at the time of the annual renewal.</p>

ALL LICENCE FEES UNDER THIS TARIFF ARE PAYABLE IN FULL, ANNUALLY IN ADVANCE. ALL AMOUNTS ARE INCLUSIVE OF GST.

PPCA will generally increase Licence Fees with effect from 1 July of each year, in line with the movement in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) since the date of the last increase or review. CPI increases will not be notified to Licensees separately, but will be applied to all invoices issued on or after 1 July in each year. Any increase in Licence Fees as a result of a broad or structural review of a Tariff will only be implemented following a period of consultation with the affected industry sector.
