TARIFF "V"

FITNESS CENTRES, GYMNASIUMS, HEALTH CLUBS and similar establishments

GENERAL LICENCE

TO COVER THE USE OF PROTECTED SOUND RECORDINGS WHEN USED AS A GENERAL AMENITY FOR THE INFORMAL ENTERTAINMENT OF PATRONS IN A FREE WEIGHTS AREA OR SPECIALISED EXERCISE TYPE EQUIPMENT AREA.

ANNUAL FEE - \$68.64

MUSIC TO ACCOMPANY FITNESS CLASSES

TO COVER THE USE OF PROTECTED SOUND RECORDINGS WHEN USED AS AN INTEGRAL PART OF EXERCISE CLASSES.

CALCULATED AT A RATE OF 96.8 CENTS PER CLASS

MINIMUM ANNUAL FEE - \$50.93

MAXIMUM ANNUAL FEE - \$2,653.64

This tariff is currently the subject of review by the Copyright Tribunal, and its decision will be handed down on May 17 2010. New rates and terms will be adjusted in accordance with that decision as soon as practicable thereafter. PPCA will post information on its website immediately following the Tribunal's determination.

FITNESS TEACHERS AND INSTRUCTORS

THIS TARIFF APPLIES TO TEACHERS AND INSTRUCTORS CONDUCTING CLASSES AT VENUES THAT WOULD NOT ORDINARILY REQUIRE A LICENCE.

CALCULATED AT A RATE OF \$1.012 PER CLASS

MINIMUM ANNUAL FEE - \$54.45

NB This tariff does not cover music video clips. (Tariff "W" is applicable.)

FEES FOR ALL LICENCES ISSUED UNDER THIS TARIFF ARE PAYABLE IN FULL ANNUALLY IN ADVANCE. THESE RATES APPLY FROM 1 JULY 2010.

PPCA will have the right to increase tariffs annually on and from 1 July in each year in line with movement in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) since the last review/increase date. Any such increase will not be notified separately, but will apply to all invoices issued after 1 July in any year. Any proposed increases resulting from broad or structural reviews will only be implemented following a period of consultation with the relevant sector.
